Access to Safety, Justice and Opportunity:

Availability of Family Violence Services across Texas

2007 Update

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The Texas Council on Family Violence has updated and refined the following charts to highlight the availability of critical core emergency services and additional support services for victims of family violence throughout the 254 counties of Texas and to highlight the gaps and unmet needs in Texas counties needing more core emergency services. It is important to recognize that while most Texas counties do have at least some access to some core emergency services, in many counties the distance to services and/or the high demand for services may mean that at times, for individual victims, immediate access to services may be a challenge. This is no different than many other human services, and is a phenomenon that local programs constantly strive to overcome.

The services of over 100 organizations serving victims of family violence across Texas are detailed by county in the attached charts. These charts were created based on results of a detailed survey and phone interviews with family violence organizations across Texas. The organizations listed are community-based nonprofit organizations that provide a wide array of services to victims of family violence to meet the needs of their diverse communities.

Contents

The two charts are divided into the availability of core emergency services and the availability of additional support services in every Texas county. These charts detail the availability of services, not the quality of services. Each chart identifies organizations listed as either being funded through the Health and Human Services Commission Family Violence Program (HHSC FVP)² or not³. The counties with no available services are also highlighted in each chart.

Chart I: Availability of Core Emergency Services.....5-31

This chart details the availability of core emergency services such as emergency shelter, emergency hotline, legal assistance and intervention/advocacy services for victims of family violence. The counties that have some services but do not meet the threshold of having comprehensive core emergency services are also highlighted in this chart.

Chart II: Availability of Additional Support Services.....33-59

This chart details the availability of additional support services, such as transitional housing, legal representation and child care, which are critical for victims of family violence to become self-sufficient and truly break out of violent relationships. Programs have developed these services despite there being very few specific specialized funding streams established for such vital services for victims of family violence. Local service providers recognize the essential nature of these additional services because of the difference they make in victims' ability to build safe futures for themselves.

Appendix I: Definitions of Services.....61-62

This appendix lists the definitions used for both the core emergency services and support services. The definitions used for core emergency services are based on the definitions of the required services for all state-funded programs by both regulations of HHSC in the Texas Administrative Code and the Texas Human Resources Code, Chapter 51. The definitions for the support services are based on standard definitions from the field that the National Domestic Violence Hotline uses when collecting data from organizations around the nation for its database of services.

²HHSC FVP-funded organizations: Ninety organizations listed in the charts are funded by the HHSC FVP. These organizations are funded as either: full service shelter centers with comprehensive nonresidential services (71 organizations), full service nonresidential centers (8 organizations) or special projects which provide either a specialized service to marginalized communities or community organizing (11 additional organizations).

³Non-HHSC FVP funded organizations: Some non-HHSC FVP funded organizations are well established programs that receive funding from other sources while others are either emerging programs or organizations that provide faith-based services that do not seek government funding. This list may not be comprehensive as not all known organizations completed the survey and some emerging programs may

Organizations not listed in charts

There are several other nonprofit organizations in Texas that focus on the issue of family violence that are not contained in these charts. These organizations fall into four categories that are described below.

Organizations focused on Community Organizing

Several nonprofit organizations around the state are engaging their communities to work toward ending and addressing family violence but are not providing direct services to victims. Because the services and initiatives undertaken by these organizations do not include either the core or support services defined in this update, these organizations are not included in these charts. Some of these organizations are funded by HHSC as special projects such as the Migrant Clinicians Network, Inc. working in the colonias of South Texas and Putting an End to Abuse through Community Efforts (P.E.A.C.E.) working in neighborhoods of San Antonio.

Legal Representation Service Organizations

Several nonprofit legal organizations are trying to meet the large demand for legal services of victims of family violence across Texas. However, despite the hard work of these organizations, access to legal representation services is still a large unmet need of victims of family violence. The vital legal services that do exist are provided, at least minimally for some victims, in every county in Texas – many through legal services that are provided over the phone or that involve long waiting lists. Because the only service provided by these organizations, for the most part, is legal representation, these organizations are not included in the attached charts.

These organizations include Legal Aid of Northwest Texas, Texas Rio Grande Legal Aid, Lone Star Legal Aid, Diocesan Migrant and Refugee Services of El Paso and the Women’s Advocacy Project, which also provides a statewide legal hotline for victims. These organizations assist victims with such legal issues as protective orders, divorces, child custody cases and immigration status. Two of these organizations (Women’s Advocacy Project and Texas Rio Grande Legal Aid) are additionally funded through HHSC FVP special project grants to assist targeted counties in Texas gain more access to legal services. TCFV is in the process of researching in more detail the availability of legal representation services across Texas for victims of family violence.

Military Installations

All U.S. military installations are mandated to provide some level of services to victims of family violence from families where at least one person is on active duty. These services are provided through the military installation’s Family Advocacy Programs or Fleet and Family Support Centers. However, because these services are under the jurisdiction of the military, the services provided on the 15 military installations in Texas have not been included in the charts.

Emerging Organizations


While these charts are comprehensive in detailing the services provided by all HHSC-funded organizations, it is not complete. Not all known non-HHSC funded organizations completed the survey and some emerging organizations may not be known to TCFV.

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Appendix I

Definition of Services

CORE EMERGENCY SERVICES

The following definitions for core emergency services are based on the definitions of the required services for all state-funded programs by both Texas Administrative Code⁴ and by the Texas Human Resources Code, Chapter 51⁵.

24-hour Emergency Shelter: A shelter facility in that county that provides access, admittance and temporary emergency residence for victims of family violence 24 hours a day, every day of the year. Organizations that only use hotels to provide shelter services or that have a homeless shelter not specifically for victims of family violence were not counted as having an emergency shelter facility.

24-hour Emergency Hotline: A telephone number answered 24 hours a day, every day of the year by trained volunteers or employees, who provide immediate intervention through safety planning, including assessing for danger; understanding and support; and information education, and referrals to victims of family violence.

Emergency Medical Care: Assistance in responding to any urgent medical situation for victim of family violence being considered for acceptance to or accessing family violence services.

Intervention: Individual or group services for victims of family violence that include safety planning; understanding and support; advocacy; case management; information and education; and resource assistance.

Emergency Transportation: Providing or arranging transportation for victims of family violence being considered for acceptance as residents of the shelter to and from emergency medical facilities and/or from a safe place to the shelter.

Legal Assistance: Services to victims of family violence that include identifying individual legal needs; explaining legal rights and options; providing support and accompaniment in the pursuit of those options; assisting in safety planning; and providing advocacy, including assistance with self-representation.

Information about Educational Arrangements: Services that result in a child of a victim of family violence complying with the compulsory attendance requirements found in the Texas Education Code.

Information about training for and seeking employment: Providing information and referrals to victims of family violence about employment training and employment opportunities, either directly or through formal arrangements with other organizations.

Services to children who victims of family violence or who accompany adult victims of family violence: Individual or group advocacy or counseling with children.

Not Meeting the Minimum Threshold of Core Emergency Services:

If a county neither has

- a. any family violence organizations that provide direct access (face-to-face) services in that county, nor
- b. any family violence organization in an adjacent county that has, at a minimum, an emergency hotline covering that county and transportation services to their emergency shelter, intervention and legal assistance services; then,

it does not meet the minimum threshold of core emergency services. This determination was not made with consideration of geography or population size of counties. In any further assessment of gaps of services based on this data, it is important to keep geography and population size in mind.

SUPPORT SERVICES

The following definitions for support services provided to victims of family violence in Texas are based on standard definitions from the field that the National Domestic Violence Hotline uses when collecting data from programs around the nation for its database of services.

Transitional Housing: Between 6 and 24 months of temporary housing with support services for victims of family violence.

Temporary financial assistance: Cash assistance for emergencies [gas, car repairs, rent utilities, child care, etc.].

Individual professional counseling: Clinical counseling with a licensed therapist.

Crime victim compensation: Assistance to victims of family violence with obtaining victims compensation benefits.

Legal representation: On-staff attorney that takes individual cases for victims of family violence.

Immigration assistance: Legal assistance, advocacy and representation regarding VAWA self-petition.

Substance abuse services: Inpatient or outpatient clinical treatment for substance abuse issues.

Mental Health services: Inpatient or outpatient psychiatric care.

Job search/placement/training: Employment training or placement services.

Child Care: Provide on-site child care and/or assistance for arranging and paying for child care.

Service to batterers: Provide a written educational curriculum for batterers in perpetrator groups with specific criteria for completion.

Non-emergency transportation: Assistance with daily transportation, i.e. bus passes, cab fare, rides to work/school, etc.
