One In The Movement (OIM) is a multi-tier approach to training and delivery of essential resources to new and tenured advocates working in family violence agencies. OIM is available to family violence service program staff, and training is offered free to our TCFV (Texas Council on Family Violence) members. Ensure your staff are trained and encourage them to attend these engagement opportunities:
