THE FOUNDATION OF OUR ANALYSIS

Honoring Texas Victims (HTV) Report: Annual review of intimate partner homicides in Texas.

 Focus: Trends, demographics, and methods of homicide.

Domestic Violence High-Risk Teams (DVHRT) Statewide Report:

- Examines communitybased high-risk intervention.
- Highlights patterns in high-lethality risk and prevention strategies.

HTV Report:

- 72% of female DV homicide victims killed with firearms.
 - Homicide-suicide cases underscore the lethality of firearms.

DVHRT Report:

- Firearms as tools of intimidation and escalation in high-lethality cases.
- Post-separation risk significantly higher with firearm access.

THE ROLE OF FIREARMS IN DV CASES

INSIGHTS FROM RISK ASSESSMENTS

- High-lethality risks often precede homicides.
- Intimidation through firearms a strong predictor of future violence.
- Common barriers: inconsistent enforcement of firearm surrender laws.

LEGAL CONTEXT AND IMPLICATIONS

- Section 922(g)(8): Prohibits firearm possession for individuals under DV restraining orders.
- Supreme Court upheld the provision as consistent with historical firearm regulation.
- Aligns with findings in DVHRT and HTV reports: court-ordered disarmament saves lives.

"Our tradition of firearm regulation allows the Government to disarmindividuals who present a credible threat to the physical safety of others."

CONNECTING RESEARCH AND LAW

- Rahimi validates findings in DVHRT and HTV reports about firearm threats.
- Emphasizes the importance of judicial determinations for public safety.
- Highlights the need for robust enforcement mechanisms.

CLOSING THE GAPS

- Strengthen firearm surrender protocols.
- Expand lethality assessments nationwide.
- Enhance survivor support and law enforcement training.
- Improve data collection for informed policymaking.

PROTECTING SURVIVORS, PREVENTING VIOLENCE

- Firearms significantly escalate DV lethality.
- The Rahimi decision reinforces targeted disarmament efforts.
- Collaboration and evidencebased policy are essential.
